Terms of Membership: Services provided under this contract shall begin on _____. A membership fee will be paid for the amount of \$195.00. This fee allows the student to participate in all classes for their age and skill level available at Water Oak Aikikai for the period of 3 months, includes one uniform and belt (provided the student is not a former student of Water Oak Aikikai or Aikido of Charlotte) and all test fees for kyu ranks. Monthly fees of \$65.00 will begin on _____. Monthly fees allow the student to participate in all classes of their age and rank at Water Oak Aikikai and all test fees for kyu ranks. The membership fee must be paid in full at the start of this contract and monthly payments must be made by the 8th of the month to participate. This contract will terminate on the 9th of the month if not paid in full and all rights included in membership to Water Oak Aikikai. To reinstate this contract 3 months must be paid for in full (advanced payment discounts are not available to students with delinquent accounts).

Promise to pay: You promise to pay the amount of \$65.00 per month by the 5th of each month. We waive any security of interest of lien which may arise by operation of law, except the lien of any judgment which we may obtain if this contract is not paid in accordance with its terms.

Restrictions/cancellation or assignment: This membership is nontransferable, non assignable and non-refundable. You may cancel this contract by notifying Water Oak Aikikai in writing by the 5th of the month.

Terms and Conditions

Law Applicable: Federal law governs the contract.

Invalid provisions: If any part of this contract is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of the contract will be valid and enforceable.

Entire agreement: This contract comprises the entire agreement pertaining to membership and no other agreement of any kind, verbal understanding or promises whatsoever will be recognized or binding on us.

Signers of the Agreement: It is your responsibility to know whether this contract is in default or that payments have been missed. We are not responsible for notifying you of late payments or any default procedures.

Assumption of Risk: The applicant desire to participate in the study of the art of Aikido at Water Oak Aikikai notwithstanding his/her awareness of the possibility of incurring physical injury in the course of such study of said art. The applicant, in consideration of being accepted as a participant in such study by Water Oak Aikikai, hereby assumes all risk of personal injury (weather anticipated or unanticipated) resulting from his/ her participation.

The parent (or guardian) of applicant who is a minor hereby agrees hold Water Oak Aikikai, its officers, instructors, and agents harmless from any liability resulting from the study and practice of said art.
